Lessons to love

- Teacher manuals come in binders containing easy to use lesson booklets and feature enhanced fluency instruction
- Directed instruction promotes classroom management, the scripted lesson design allows teachers to concentrate on teaching rather than on lesson preparation
- Student worksheets apply the skills they are learning such as coding words.
- Cumulative, diagnostic assessments integrated into the instruction measure progress and provide remediation for children who need additional mastering skills.

Practice Makes Perfect

- Wall cards serve as reminders for children and reinforce the phonics and reading concepts they are learning.
- Review Decks expand, enhance, and integrate each day's instruction by providing practice and review.
- Kids Cards provide a fun, hands-on way to review and remediate phonics skills.
- Colorful, engaging posters remind children of phonics concepts and the most effective writing and listening positions.

Motivating Reading Experiences

- Engaging stories and Illustrations motivate children to read, and the black and white format allows them to color and individualize their own set of books.
- Color Versions of the decodable readers are available to use in a class library.
- Three types of fluency masters promote automaticity with high frequency words, provide focused practice with expression and access student's fluency progress.
- Easy, average, and challenging leveled fluency readers provide practice for all children from the struggling student to the more advanced.
- Comprehension questions at the end of the story assess children's understanding.
- Students read at his or her own level, but still participate in group comprehension activities.

What about Spelling and Handwriting?

- Spelling lists are provided for children to practice at home for an end of the week test.
- Each list consists of words that contain only those letters and sounds children have learned. Sight words with irregular spellings are indicated with an asterisk.
- To help introduce second-graders to various handwriting and reading concepts. These masters, are found in the Teacher's Resource Binder.
- Sight words masters reinforce the correct spellings and recognition of nonphonetic words that must be memorized.

In a Nutshell

Saxon phonics and spelling k-3 helps children master the essential foundational skills of phonemic awareness, alphabetizing, decoding, fluency and spelling.
